

APHIDS

These pests spread quickly—they can cover entire surfaces of the plant if left untreated. In addition to harming the plant by sucking sap, aphids also attract ants and foster the growth of mold.

WHAT TO LOOK OUT FOR:

Aphids emerge during early spring and fall. They can be found on the underside of leaves and on flower buds.

SIGNS OF INFESTATION:

Aphids cause honeydew on your plant's leaves, which you may find ants harvesting. They also leave behind a black sooty mold.

PREVENTION

Aphids can be prevented with the application of a systemic insecticide at the onset of growing season. Keep an eye on the newest growth as well as any flower buds to quickly spot any infestations.
