

CATERPILLARS

One of the most damaging pests encountered. Caterpillars chew away leaves, diminishing growth and leaving the plant visually unappealing.

WHAT TO LOOK OUT FOR:

Caterpillars emerge during early spring and fall. They can be found on new leaf growth.





SIGNS OF INFESTATION:

Caterpillars will cause leaves to turn brown and become a papery texture. They will also leave behind a silky webbing.

HOW TO TREAT:

MONITORING

Keep an eye on the new growth of any susceptible plants for signs of caterpillar infestation. These may include fine webbing, browning of the leaves, or the buildup of small, black excrement.

FERTILIZER

Caterpillars can eat dozens of leaves a day, taking a huge toll on any infested plants! To help your plant bounce back and re-gain any lost growth, be sure to apply Super Charged Moon Juice™ and Moon Dust™.

TREATMENT

Caterpillars are most effectively controlled by topical sprays. Be sure to thoroughly coat the surfaces of the leaves and follow all instructions on the chemical label. After treating, conduct a light prune to remove any unsightly damaged leaves.
