

LEAFMINERS

Leafminers damage the leaves of plants by feeding within very thin tunnels on the upper surface of the leaf. These leaves will dry up as the insects do their damage

WHAT TO LOOK OUT FOR:

Look for this pest on the upper surface of the leaves in the spring and fall.





SIGNS OF INFESTATION:

Leafminers leave behind a silver, papery tunnel where they feed. Tunnels coupled with distorted growth are a sure sign of infestation.

Leafminer infestations can be prevented through application of a systemic insecticide at the onset of growing season.
