

MEALYBUGS

This quick-spreading insect damages plants by feeding on sap, causing yellow and stunted growth.

WHAT TO LOOK OUT FOR:

Mealybugs emerge during the spring and can be found on stems between leaves and fruits.





SIGNS OF INFESTATION:

Mealybugs are a messy pest that leave honeydew on your plants, which leads to the growth of sooty mold. They also leave behind a white, waxy substance on their feeding sites.

HOW TO TREAT:

PREVENTION

An application of systemic insecticide at the onset of growing season can protect your plants from mealybugs.

FERTILIZER
