



SPIDER MITES

Mites are tiny arachnids that puncture the surface of plant leaves and feed on the sugars and nutrients within. Infestations can become severe during warm months and can kill a plant if left untreated.

WHAT TO LOOK OUT FOR:

Spider mite infestations are more common during warm weather. They can be spotted on the underside of leaves.



SIGNS OF INFESTATION:

Spider mites create fine, white webbing on the leaves of plants. As the infestation grows, leaves will develop yellow blotches and will eventually turn brown.

HOW TO TREAT:

PREVENTION

Spider mites thrive in dry, dusty conditions—therefore it is important to keep plants properly watered throughout the warm summer months! See our Watering Guides for information on how to properly water your plants all year long. For any plants prone to collecting dust, like cypress, spraying them with water first thing in the morning during the summer months will help eliminate the dust and knock down the mites.

FERTILIZER

TREATMENT
