


THRIPS

Thrips damage plants by piercing leaf surfaces and sucking out sugars and nurtrients. They are often too small to see with the naked eye, but can be easily recognized by the damage they cause.

WHAT TO LOOK OUT FOR:

Thrips will be the most active during your plant's growing season. Any damage they cause will be present on the plant's leaves and fruits.





SIGNS OF INFESTATION:

Thrips will cause leaves to become curled and stunted with dead patches. On fruits you can find scarring near the stem attachment.

HOW TO TREAT:

PREVENTION

Eliminating weeds in your landscaping can help prevent infestations by minimizing habitat for thrips to multiply and spread. You can also effectively prevent thrip infestations through the application of a systemic insecticide at the onset of growing season.

FERTILIZER

TREATMENT
