

WHITEFLIES

These small insects spread quickly from plant to plant, sucking out sap and vital nutrients.

WHAT TO LOOK OUT FOR:

Whiteflies are most commonly found during warm weather, congregating on the underside of leaves.





SIGNS OF INFESTATION:

Whiteflies can cause leaves to yellow and honeydew to form. If left untreated, affected leaves will die and fall off.

HOW TO TREAT:

PREVENTION

Eliminating weeds in your landscaping can help prevent infestations by minimizing habitat for whitefly to multiply and spread. You can also effectively prevent whitefly infestations through the application of a systemic insecticide at the onset of growing season.

FERTILIZER
